- Notes: — 1. *Classification: First Division 60%; Second Division 48% and Pass 36% in the total aggregate.
2. For a pass, a candidate is required to obtain atleast 25% marks in each theory paper and 36% marks in the total aggregate at the Previous and Final Examinations separately as well as 36% marks in practical separately wherever prescribed.
3. Circle around the marks denotes deficiency in the Paper/Total.
4. (a) Ord. 212-A candidate who has failed at M.A. Previous examination but has passed in at least 50% of the papers prescribed for the examination obtaining 36% marks in each paper in accordance with the rules given below shall be eligible to re-appear in the failing papers of Previous alongwith the Final examination.

or a pass, a candidate is required to obtain at least 36% marks in the subsidiary subject, and 40% marks in the Honours subject; provided that in the case of subject where practical examination is prescribed a candidate is required to pass in theory as well as in practical separately in order to pass in the subject.

(i) A candidate who fails in the aggregate of Subsidiary/Honours subject consisting of theory papers only or in the aggregate of the theoretical part only of a subject consisting of theory as well as practical, but taking each paper separately secures the minimum pass marks in all except one paper, shall be deemed to have failed in that Paper only in which he fails to secure the minimum pass marks.

(ii) A candidate who fails at the Honour Pt. II Exam. in (a) not more than one theory paper/practical of the subsidiary subject and/or (b) not more than one theory paper/practical of the Hon. subject shall be eligible to appear at the supplementary Exam. The minimum pass marks prescribed for all the theory papers of a subject taken together distributed over the different Papers in proportion of their maximum marks will give the minimum pass marks for each individual paper. If the marks so worked out are in fraction, the same shall be raised to the next higher whole number.

(iii) A candidate, who desires theoretical at the supple. exam., is deemed to have secured the minimum pass marks only prescribed for the paper/practical irrespective of the marks actually obtained by him/her for the purpose of determining whether division at the Honours Part II Examination and also for the purpose of admission to a higher course of study.

Classification —
First Division—60% or 720 and above
Second Division—50% or 600 and above
Rest will be declared to have passed

Candidates desiring revaluation/scrutiny of their answer-book/result should apply on the prescribed form so as to reach the Registrar office within 30 days from the date of the declaration of the result. Applications received after the due date shall NOT be entertained in any case. Blank application forms can be had from the Dy. Registrar (Secy)

If a candidate is unable to pass completely the Honours Part I and II Examinations within a maximum period of Four Years from the date of commencement of the academic session in which he/she was admitted to the Honours Part I class, the examination passed by him/her, if any, shall stand cancelled. Inability to avail a chance shall be treated as failure.

A circle drawn around the marks denotes failure in that paper/subject.

In case of any mistake being detected during the preparation of the marks-sheets or brought to notice afterwards, the University will be fully empowered to correct the same (Ord. 169-B).
